



# iMovie Assignments

## Session 1

### Assignment

We have provided video clips for editing. They are located in the 300 folder. You are required to create a short film using these clips for this week's assignment. Complete the following tasks with these video clips.

1. Create a **1-minute** movie using the stock video clips.
2. Add at least **3 transitions** and **2 chapters**.
3. Add a **title page**.
4. Use one of the **video special effects**.
5. Add at least **two audio special effects**. This can include one sound effect and music or a voiceover.
6. Make the movie by **Exporting** it—use CD ROM Quality.
7. Turn into the **Drop Box (/) 5:00pm**.

### Homework

1. Bring in a **storyboard** of a video you would like to make. This can be a project for a class, an ad, short movie, or—and this is if you can't think of anything—you can pick a movie idea out of the Idea Hat. It's a grab bag of movie-making fun!  
**The film you create must be at least 3 minutes long.**
2. Check out a **digital video camera** and **tripod** from Instructional Support Services (it is located near the library), remember to ask for a *firewire* cable that will attach the camera to a Mac computer and buy the correct kind of videotape for the camera so you can record.

## Session 2

### Assignment

We'll film for part of the class and have you practice using the digital camera and tripod. When we return, we'll import what you've shot and practice cutting the film. **Storyboard due at the beginning of class!**

### Homework

1. Shoot film for the video project you are going to create.

## Session 3

### Assignment

For the first part of class, we will show you how to use iDVD to make a sweet menu for your flick.

Bring what you have shot so far for your film. We'll help you import and edit. We'll try to help you get things to work right.

### Homework

Complete your film and turn it in on (/) **by noon**. Turn it in on a CD to the consultant on duty.

You can make a documentary, an art film, a commercial, or something else for this class or a project for another class. The only stipulations are that your video *must be at least 3 minutes long* and include:

1. A voiceover.
1. Music.

2. At least three transitions.
3. Two video special effects.
4. Two audio special effects.
5. A title page.
6. Credits.
7. Three Chapters.
8. iDVD menu.
